

# Proverbs 22 (Sayings of the Wise)

Start of 30 wise sayings (5 are covered)

### Prov 22:1 A good name is to be chosen rather than great riches, Loving favor rather than silver and gold.

- Being very rich King Solomon
- A good name is an asset whose currency is unaffected by the boom or bust of the material world

#### Examples:

- Benaiah son of Jehoiada ( 2 Samuel 23:20) King David's 30 mighty men
- Jesus (Before Christ and After Death)

#### Prov 22:2 The rich and the poor have this in common, The Lord is the maker of them all.

- God's sight all people have equal value and dignity
- Must respect them as fellow human beings
- Job 34:19Yet He is not partial to princes, Nor does He regard the rich more than the poor; For they *are* all the work of His hands.

### Prov 22:3 A prudent man foresees evil and hides himself, But the simple pass on and are punished.

### Prov 22:4 By humility and the fear of the Lord Are riches and honor and life.

• 1Peter 5:5-6- Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to *your* elders. Yes, all of *you* be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for

"God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."

 <sup>6</sup> Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, Mat 5:1- Blessed *are* the poor in spirit, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

- Riches Vs Poor
- Honor Vs Insult
- Life Vs Hell

Examples: Abraham, Job, Moses (Numbers 12:3 - Now the man Moses was very humble, more than all men who were on the face of the earth.

Prov 22:5 -Thorns *and* snares *are* in the way of the perverse; He who guards his soul will be far from them.

## Prov 22: 6 - Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.

- Hebew word Hanak means dedicate.
- Channeling Child's conduct into way of wisdom.
- Preparing the child for future responsibilies.
- The Hebrew word of "child" is na'ar -refers to a "marriageable male while still single".

7 The rich rules over the poor, And the borrower *is* servant to the lender.

8 He who sows iniquity will reap sorrow, [b] And the rod of his anger will fail.

9 He who has a generous eye will be blessed, For he gives of his bread to the poor.

10 Cast out the scoffer, and contention will leave; Yes, strife and reproach will cease.

- 11 He who loves purity of heart And has grace on his lips, The king will be his friend.
- 12 The eyes of the Lord preserve knowledge, But He overthrows the words of the faithless.
- 13 The lazy man says, "There is a lion outside! I shall be slain in the streets!"
- 14 The mouth of an immoral woman is a deep pit; He who is abhorred by the Lord will fall there.
- 15 Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; The rod of correction will drive it far from him.
- 16 He who oppresses the poor to increase his riches, And he who gives to the rich, will surely come to poverty.

#### 5 Wise Sayings out of 30

17 Incline your ear and hear the words of the wise, And apply your heart to my knowledge;

18 For it is a pleasant thing if you keep them within you; Let them all be fixed upon your lips,

19 So that your trust may be in the Lord; I have instructed you today, even you.

20 Have I not written to you excellent things Of counsels and knowledge,

21 That I may make you know the certainty of the words of truth,
That you may answer words of truth
To those who send to you?

- 22 Do not rob the poor because he *is* poor, Nor oppress the afflicted at the gate;
- 23 For the LORD will plead their cause, And plunder the soul of those who plunder them.

24 Make no friendship with an angry man, And with a furious man do not go,

26 Do not be one of those who shakes hands in a pledge,
One of those who is surety for debts;
27 If you have nothing with which to pay,
Why should he take away your bed from under you?

### Prov 22:28 Do not remove the ancient landmark Which your fathers have set.

- Joshua distributed Canaan among the various tribes of Israel (14 Chapter to 19)
- Some borders were undoubtedly marked by special stone.
- Farmers also sometimes marked the boundaries of their property with such stones.
- Moving boundaries in fields, usually marked by stone pillars or piles of stones resulted in individuals losing and gaining property and wealth.
   In Israel. This was also a sin against God
- God owned and portioned all the land (Deut. 19:14;27:17; Job 24:2a).

Prov 22:29 Do you see a man who excel s in his work? He will stand before kings; He will not stand before unknow n men.

Quality of a person's work ( not Bribes or flattery).
