The Eschatological "Days" in Scripture

- 1. Last Days (Heb.1:2; 2Tim.3:1; 2Pet.3:3)
- 2. The Day of Our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Cor.1:8 & 5:5; Phil.1:6, 10).
- 3. The Day of the Lord (Joel 1:15; 2:1-2; 10-11; Amos 5:18, 20; Isa.2:12; 13:6,9; 1Thess.5:2; 2Thess.2:2; 2Pet. 3:10).

The Eschatological "Days" in Scripture

- 4. Day of God (2Pet. 3:12).
- 5. Day of Eternity (2Pet. 3:18).

- Anti = Against, instead of.
- Only in John's Epistles (1Jn.2:18, 22; 4:3, 2Jn. 7).
- Different from "False Christ" (Matt.24:24; Mk. 13:22).

Both a "Program" and a "Person."

- 1. The spirit of Antichrist anti Christian teaching with demonic influence.
- 2. Many "antichrists" present and active in John's time and throughout church history.
- 3. The great coming Antichrist.

- 2. The lawless one (2 Thess.2:8)
- 3. The evil man (2 Thess.2:9)
- 4. The son of destruction (2 Thess.2:3)

- 5. A fierce king (Dan.8:23)
- 6. A master of intrigue/sinister schemes (Dan.8:23)
- 7. The Prince who is to come (Dan.9:26)
- 8. A worthless shepherd (Zech11:16-17)

HIS PERSONALITY

- 1. He will be a charismatic leader (Daniel 7:7-8, 25; Rev. 13:5).
- 2. He will be a cunning leader (Daniel 11:21).
- 3. He will be a cruel leader (Daniel 7:23, 25).
