The five solas

Sola scriptura (Scripture alone), is the belief that because Scripture is God's inspired Word, it is the only inerrant, sufficient, and final authority for the church.

Solus Christus (Christ ONLY / alone) – is the assertion that Christ alone is the basis on which the ungodly are justified in God's sight.

Sola fide (faith alone), - maintains that the believer receives the redemption Christ has accomplished only through faith.

Sola gratia (grace alone), proclaims that all of our salvation, from beginning to end, is by grace and grace alone.

Soli Deo gloria (glory to God alone). that only God receives glory for our salvation.

What is the theme made in Romans?:

- Rom 1:16-17
- For I am not ashamed of the gospel,
 - for it is the power of God for salvation
 - to everyone who believes,
 - to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
- For in it
 - the righteousness of God is revealed
 - from faith for faith,
 - as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."
