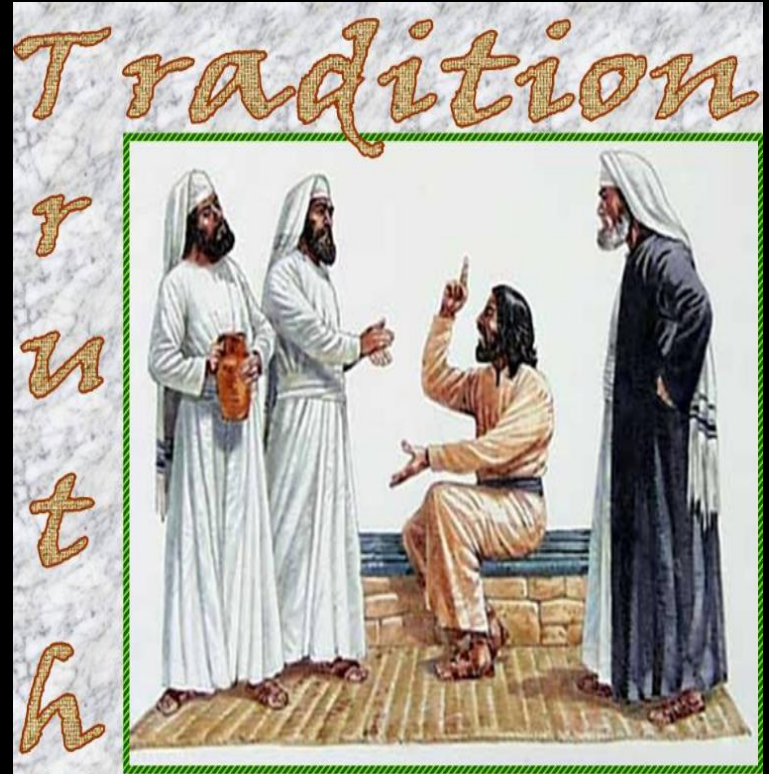

Matthew Ch.15 (Verses 1 through 14, NIV)

Matthew Ch.15 (Verses 15 & 16, NIV):

15: Peter said, “Explain the parable to us.”

16: “Are you still so dull?” Jesus asked them.

Peter's Vision:

Acts Ch.10

*“Peter, do not call
impure what God
has made clean”*

**Verse 15*



Questions of Application:

*Where do we tend to be a Pharisee?

*Where do we tend to drive activities that more about the outward appearance and less about the state of our heart?

Question:

*Can a believer be born again, outwardly religious, and yet NOT truly be a follower of the Word of God?

Matthew Ch.15 (Verses 17 through 20, NIV):

17: *“Don’t you see that whatever enters the mouth goes into the stomach and then out of the body?”*

18: *But the things that come out of a person’s mouth come from the heart, and these defile them.*

19: *For out of the heart come evil thoughts—murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander.*

20: *These are what defile a person; but eating with unwashed hands does not defile them.”*

Jeremiah Ch.17 (Verses 9 & 10, NIV):

*9: The heart is deceitful above all things
and beyond cure.*

Who can understand it?

*10: “I the Lord search the heart
and examine the mind,
to reward each person according to their conduct,
according to what their deeds deserve.”*

Matthew Ch.5 (Verse 20, NIV):

20: For I tell you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you will certainly not enter the kingdom of heaven.
