Malachi 1:2-5 – Rejecting God's Love

1:6 - that they gave Him less honor than the natural son would give to his father

1:7,8 - the priests despised His name to the extent that they offered polluted food on His altar - anything they did not want themselves

1:12,13 - they profaned His name and regarded His service as weariness

3:8 – they were robbing Him by the withholding of tithes and offerings

3:13-15 – Abusing God's Grace

Relationships with one another

Malachi 2:10 – speaks of them dealing treacherously one with another

2:11 – speaks of unequal yokes being forged with idolators

2:14 - tell of the ease with which they were breaking their marriage vows

God has never left Himself without a light among His people. There was a remanent of people true to Jehovah

Malachi 3:16 - they were those that feared the Lord

- they had fellowship one with another
- they meditate on His Name

- Verse 16 suggests the main subject matter of their conversation- 'they mediate upon his Name'
 - His character, His Person, His Greatness. Not current events, not politics, not social responsibility, no matter how important these things were.

"They mediate upon his Name" is 'they made an inventory of His Name.' 'His Name' would, of course, be Jehovah, His name in relation to Israel, in distinction from the many titles that He bears.

Seven times the name of the Lord (Jehovah) in the Old Testament is linked with an expression which is a revelation of His character in relation to His people.

These names were in all probability the treasures that those old saints rejoiced in, and which strengthened them in those dark days.
